Rosie Reader Classroom Visits


- 239 preschool classroom visits 3,769 kids in attendance
- 84 elementary school classroom visits 1,850 kids in attendance
- 21 after-school visits 516 kids in attendance
- Total: 344 classroom visits 6,135kids in attendance


Rosie Reader Book Pick of the Month
